

REDUCE MOSQUITO BITES

The most effective method of reducing the mosquito population, and the viruses they may carry is to eliminate their breeding sites. The following suggestions will contribute to a safer summer in your neighborhood and throughout the community.

Dispose of old tires, tin cans, buckets, drums, bottles or other water collectors. Make sure gutters drain properly. Empty wading pools, bird baths and plant pots once a week. Eliminate brush, high grass and weeds.
